The Petersburg Economic Development Council Adult Education Scholarship is intended to assist a Petersburg resident to take post-secondary classes via distance education, or to attend a vocational training workshop.

The PEDC gives first consideration to an applicant who has had little or no opportunity to pursue an education or training beyond a high school. However, individuals, who already have attended college or vocational training, are encouraged to apply.

Scholarship Terms

Scholarship recipient may use funds for tuition, fees, or books. Scholarship will be mailed directly to the institution where the recipient is enrolled upon verification of enrollment and good standing.

Eligibility Requirements

Current resident of the City of Petersburg

18 years of age or older

Applied to or enrolled in a program leading to a degree or certificate

Application Requirements

1. Completed application form
2. Proof of Residency (for example, copy of voter registration card, utility bill, mortgage payment with applicants name)
3. Letters of recommendation from employer (optional)
